There is a great emphasis on devising new methods of works and using technologies, such as Building Information Modelling (BIM) and Modular Integrated Construction (MiC), for enhancing quantity, speed, efficiency and quality for delivery of different infrastructure projects. There is also a considerable focus on sustainable development and de-carbonisation in the design of these infrastructure projects. In view of the huge construction volume in the years to come, there are many opportunities for civil engineers to participate in these mega projects and bring different methods of works and technologies in building of a smart, green and liveable city as well as developing your professional career.
