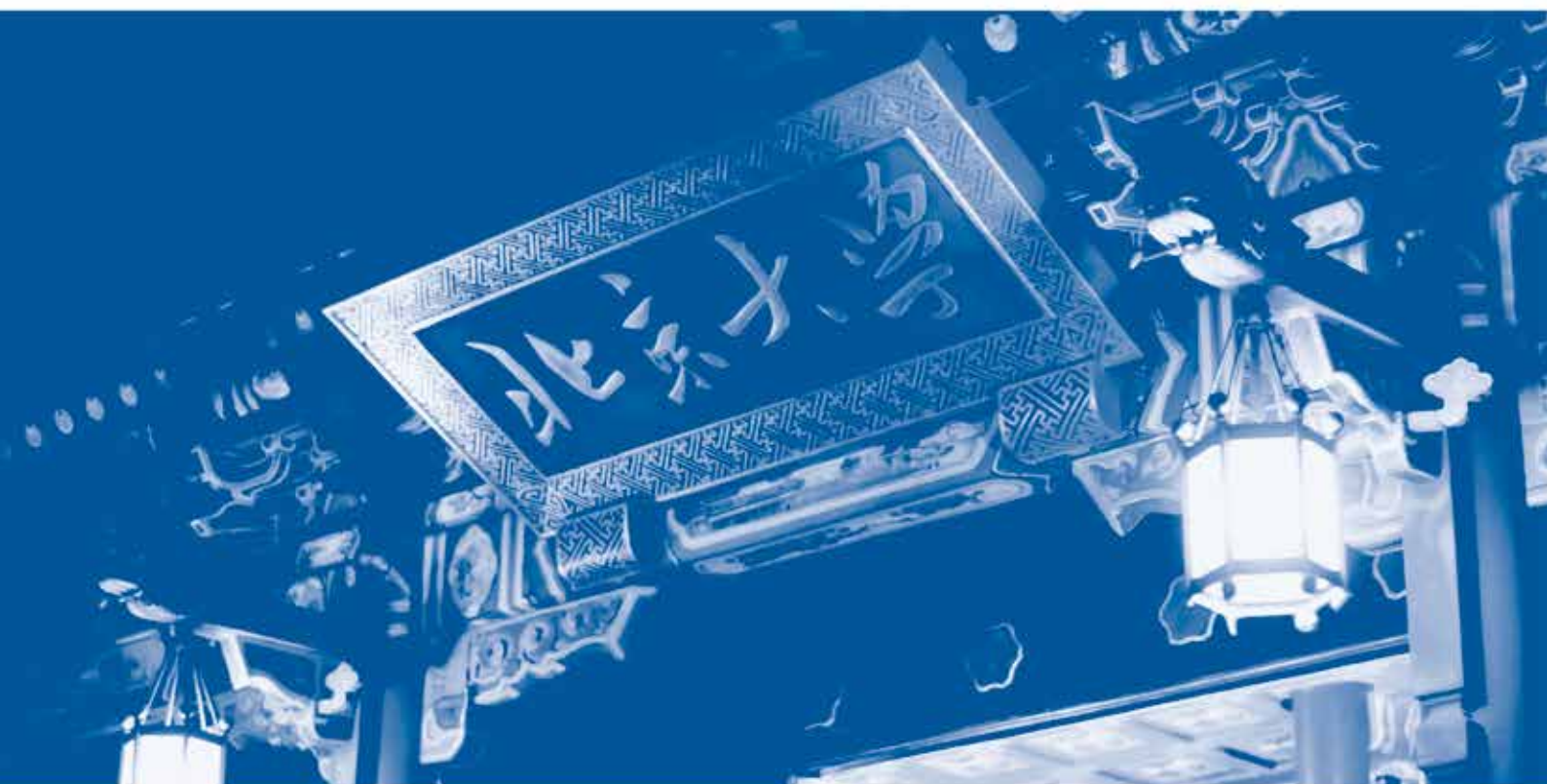

The first year is spent at the School of Government at Peking University, with a focus on public policy in China and the Asia Pacific region. - obtaining two degrees through studying at two of the best universities in the social sciences in China and in Europe

Note: Students will be expected to choose courses to the value of one unit from a range of options in public management and comparative public policy and administration. Course choice and acceptance into specific courses depends on the availability of courses in a given year, staffing resources, the number of seminars offered for a particular course and student demand. The courses above represent the current structure of the MSc Public Policy and Administration but this may be subject to alteration.

+ Degree Conferral

Students are required to successfully complete 19 credit-worth course work and a master thesis and thesis defense within the first year. After meeting the above requirements, students can get approval of the LSE year study, after getting the degree from LSE, with the approval of PKU Degree Committee, the master degree of Management in Public Policy will be awarded from PKU. The two degrees cannot be awarded separately if students fail in one side.

A double degree program student must fulfil the graduation requirements of both degree programs. The VUW MIR degree requires 210 points with a minimum score of 50 marks for core and elective courses and the thesis course. The PKU MPP degree requires 30 credits with a minimum score of 70 marks for every compulsory course and a minimum score of 60 marks for every elective course, and a pass grade for the thesis component.

The PKU-Sciences Po dual degree is a two-year full-time academic program. Students spend their first year at Paris School of International Affairs (PSIA), Sciences Po, where they can choose from the 7 specialised programs in international affairs. In the second year, students will study at the School of International Studies (SIS), Peking University for the degree of Master of International Relations, whose focus is on security and development issues and a regional focus on China and the Asia-Pacific region.

Final graduation will rely on the student's qualified performance in both years of the programme. Therefore, students will get a temporary graduation in July of the first year at Sciences Po, while the final graduation is upon the completion of all required studies at Peking University in the second year.

Upon successful completion of studies at both institutions, students will be conferred Master Degree of Law and Master Degree of International Affairs by PKU and Sciences Po respectively.

This program provides an intensive instruction in Chinese law. Leading faculty members will offer Chinese law courses specially designed for international students. Teaching will comprise of both lectures and small-group seminars. In addition, Peking University regularly attracts top scholars and practitioners in Chinese law and students will have first-hand access to such distinguished presenters. There are also optional subjects in non-law areas such as politics, economy and society to facilitate students' understanding of China's culture. Moreover, courses on Mandarin Chinese are available for the improvement of language skill and adaption to local residence.

The LL.M. Program offers assistance to students in seeking internship opportunities at top law firms and other legal institutions in China, with a hope to avail them with a better comprehension of the Chinese legal system and its cultural underpinnings. Through the program, students can establish a solid foundation for their career development relating to China.

Students are required to enroll in a minimum of 36 credits including all required courses and pass all course examinations.

In order to obtain the LL.M. degree, students must complete the master's thesis relating to Chinese law and pass the thesis defence. A master's thesis shall be 12,000 words or more, and be written in Chinese or English. A thesis that is written in English shall include a summary in Chinese of about 3,000 Chinese characters.

After approved by the Peking University Degree Committee, the students can receive the LL.M. Program's graduation certificate and the degree certificate for the Master of Laws.

The Yenching Academy is a fully-funded residential program offering a wide array of interdisciplinary courses on China within the Humanities and Social Sciences. Working closely with their academic mentors, Yenching Scholars have the flexibility to create their own study paths by choosing from six academic concentrations and a variety of extracurricular activities. Studying at the Academy represents a unique opportunity not only for intercultural and academic exchange, but also for personal and professional development.

Scholars have much flexibility to customize their research. They complete required courses and electives offered by the Yenching Academy and/or Peking University. Graduation requires successful completion of at least 30 academic credits, as well as writing and orally defending a master's thesis. Chinese language study is compulsory for international students.

Scholars participate in field studies to culturally, economically, or socio-politically significant regions within Mainland China. Each Scholar chooses one of six research areas corresponding to thesis topic. (The research area does not affect course selection options or requirements, but should correspond to thesis topic.)

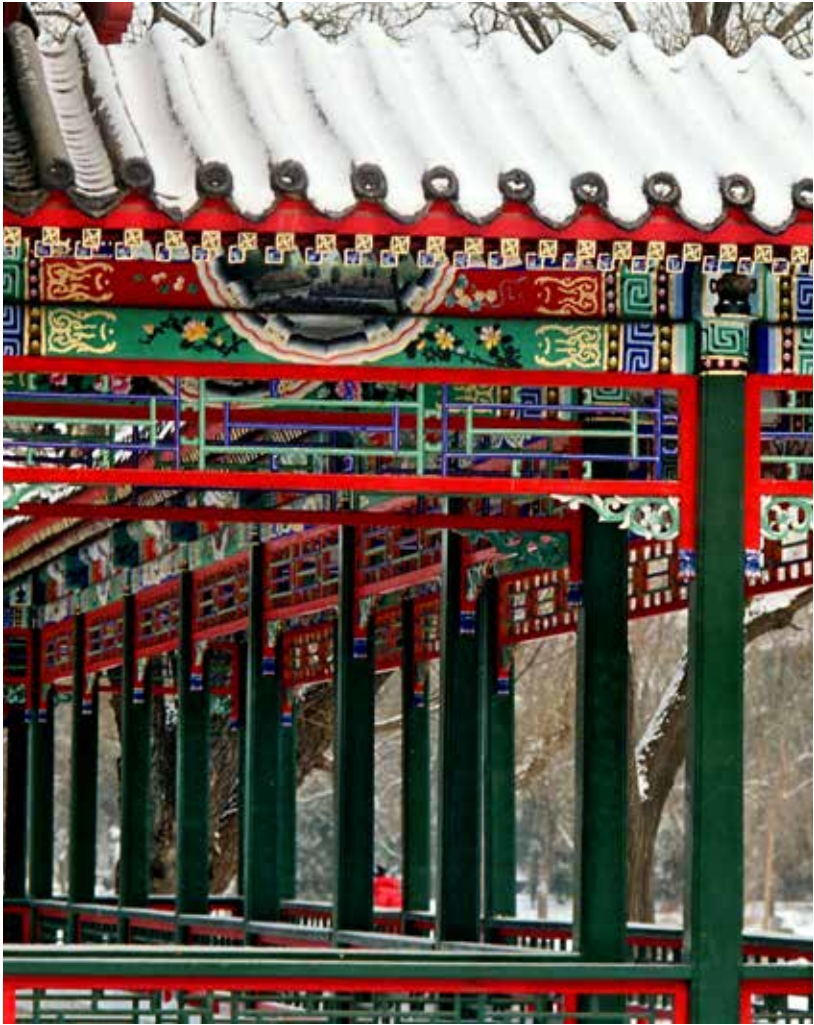

The International Ph.D Program (IPh.D) of Guanghua aims at educating and developing young management scholars who are able to conduct highly qualified scientific research, to advance the quality of management research in China and globally.

Modeled after Ph.D programs in North American research universities, the full-time program is designed for candidates with outstanding intellectual abilities and strong commitment to research, to produce university faculty members who are excellent researchers and teachers, especially in business schools. The program uses English language for main area courses, papers, and dissertations. The program faculty includes many famous international scholars who teach some of the courses and serve as students' dissertation committees.

Students are not allowed to work on non-research projects while enrolled in the IPh.D program. An opportunity to participate in international exchange is provided on competitive basis. Academic Conference Travel Fund is provided for international conference attendance if a student presents a first or single author paper.

The program follows a strict annual-review system. Those who cannot pass the annual review may be disqualified from continuing in the IPh. D study the next year. Such students may be allowed to complete a Master's degree instead.
